Be on the look out for the bright yellow duck within the next week or two to begin purchasing your duck race tickets.

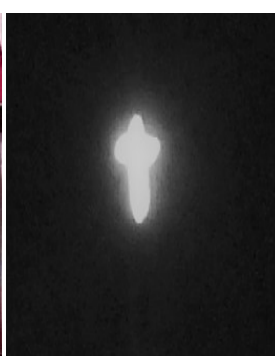
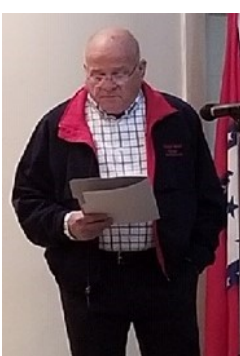
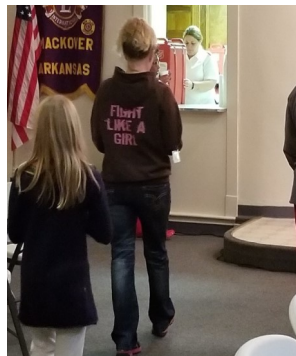
